Responsibilities for minimising COVID spread whilst a patient in hospital

- Increase hand hygiene frequency using facilities provided
- Wear a surgical face mask which will be provided for you by the staff
- If you are unable to tolerate the surgical mask or refuse, this will be clearly documented within your medical notes
- Maintain 2 metre social distance where possible when mobilising
- Only leave your bed area if going to the toilet or going off the ward for investigations
- 6. Do not bring unnecessary items in with you as this can inhibit effective cleaning
- A nominated family member or friend can be provided with information updates.
 Please ask staff for further information
- Maternity patients should only have a single birthing partner or sole visitor.
 Children should only have one parent
- Immediately inform a staff member if there is a change in your condition e.g. cough, sore throat, no taste or smell
- 10. Inform staff immediately if you have ever had a COVID positive test
